**Everett Area School District Summer School Credit Recovery Program**

Dear Parent:

All of the Credit Recovery Summer School offerings in the Everett Area School District will be based on students' need for academic remediation or credit recovery. Our summer school program will take advantage of today's technology by providing a convenient and web-based interactive learning resource called Edgenuity. Our web-based credit recovery summer program takes school-year curriculum credits not attained during the traditional school year and provides an opportunity for your child to obtain the credits within this five-week program.

All EASD Credit Recovery Summer School registration will begin May 7, 2018 and close on May 25, 2018. Applications will be available in the school's Counselor's Office, Adam Whisel's Office, or in the High School Office. Each summer school course has the option to be offered either as a customized or full course.

**Customized Course Option**

You may choose to take a prescriptive test at the beginning of your course, eliminating material already mastered, customizing the course for you. This test will be given on Friday, May 25, 2018. If you choose this option you must have your registration form and payment turned in by **May 25, 2018**.

**Full Course Option**

If you choose not to take the prescriptive test, and take the course in its entirety, you have until May 25, 2018 to register. Applications will be due to Adam Whisel or the guidance counselors by May 25th.
